

Poster Information

1. **Poster Size:** All posters must be no larger than 4 feet (122 cm) high by 6 feet (1.8 meters) wide. The 13th ICR organizing committee reserves the right to remove posters that exceed the 4 ft x 6 ft size limit.
2. **Poster Format:** Including the Abstract is optional unless the scientific content has been altered since its submission.*

Required Elements of the poster are as follows:

- **Introduction / Background:** a brief discussion of the background or rationale of the study and/or the question addressed
- **Materials and Methods:** the experimental approach, materials, and methods used in the study
- **Results:** the data and results obtained in the study
- **Conclusions:** the conclusions and/or implications of the results
- **References and Acknowledgements**

* NOTE: If the scientific content of the submitted abstract has been altered since its submission, the revised abstract must be included in the poster, as well as a notice stating that a revised abstract is included.

3. **Presenting Author:** The First Author is also considered the Presenting Author and has the following responsibilities:

The Presenting Author is expected to register for the Retreat and attend the poster at the assigned time period to discuss the study and answer questions. If the Presenting Author is unable to attend the Retreat to present the poster, every effort should be made to arrange for one of the other authors to present the poster.

The Presenting Author is expected to ensure that the abstract poster conforms to the Rules for Poster Display at the Retreat (i.e., poster display size, format, and schedule).

4. **Poster Schedule:** All posters will be on display July 7, 8 and 9th, 2015. You are expected to have your poster in place by 1:00 pm July 7th and leave your posters on display until at least through 3:00 pm on July 9th. If you must leave before 3:00 pm on July 9th, please arrange for a colleague to remove your poster. See the online Preliminary Program for a current poster attendance schedule.
